Paula Goes Behind the Scenes with Hollywood...

For those who have been reading our Parish Newsletter over the past two weeks, you will know that St Monica’s buildings and grounds were temporarily closed for the filming of an upcoming movie, “Honeymoon with Harry”.

Over the past three days I have had the fascinating experience of watching a production team completely transform our surroundings. The four-pew space at the entrance to our Church became a hospital setting, while our carpark and exterior spaces were recreated to resemble a Caribbean location. Hours upon hours of preparation, lighting, camera work and direction all came together to film a scene that will likely appear on screen for less than three minutes!

Although brief, the scene featured three internationally renowned actors — Kevin Costner, Jake Gyllenhaal and Shaggy. At times I wonder why we become so excited when famous actors are nearby, yet I must admit that seeing such well-known figures walking around our grounds at St Monica’s, was, in itself, rather exciting.

What was most important throughout the entire process, however, was that the sacred nature of our Church and grounds was always respected. From our earliest conversations with the production team, it was made very clear that St Monica’s is first and foremost a place of worship and prayer. Those expectations were understood, honoured and respected at every stage of creation and filming. The crew conducted themselves professionally and courteously, always mindful that they were working within a sacred space.

Apart from assisting a production team that was drawn to the unique beauty and character of our location, the Parish also benefited financially from the arrangement.

The production company maintained strict restrictions around photography because of the difficulties paparazzi and enthusiastic fans can create. However, I was able to persuade them that our Parishioners — the people to whom this sacred space belongs — would appreciate a photograph for the newsletter. Kevin Costner very graciously agreed to have this photo taken and to allow us to publish it here.
